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Introduction

Health first, Aloha believes that health is the most important thing for a person, the greatest blessing of Allah Almighty. The root of all happiness is health.

The main inspiration behind the establishment of Aloha was health care. The head of the Aloha family, Mother Foyzun Nessa and father Mohammad Ali, had the dream of ensuring medical care for the helpless, poor, and needy people. Nurturing the dream of their parents, Aloha Health Care Center and Hospital was established in 1998. Gradually, Aloha Health Care Center and Hospital have gained wide recognition as a reliable institution providing quality health care to the common people in the area. Gradually, the scope of work and scope of services of the hospital have increased. Modern medical equipment, doctors and medical staff have also increased in number. Accommodation facilities for patients have increased, regular patient specialists are visiting Aloha Health Center and Hospital, seeing patients. In 2025, women's disease specialists provided medical services to 550 patients in both indoor and outdoor at Dinajpur Aloha Health Centers. Aloha Hospital has a wide reputation for eye treatment, eye patients from many distant places come to get eye treatment from this hospital. In 2025, a total of 5,967 patients received medical services at Aloha Health Center and Hospital, including 5,701 outdoor patients and 266 indoor patients. . The hospital's medical team has been organizing medical camps at the village level every week. In 2025, 44 eye camps were organized, through which 2355 patients were provided medical services. Maintaining cleanliness and providing health services according to rules is one of the specialties of Aloha Health Center and Hospital.

Trained and skilled manpower

The expected skills of the hospital's doctors and medical staff are an important priority. Aloha authorities organize training and exchange of views with utmost importance to enhance the skills of doctors and medical staff. In 2025, experienced trainer Christian Gurubar, who came from Germany, and other external skilled trainers have provided training to the doctors and staff of Aloha Hospital. In addition, the doctors and health workers of the hospital actively participate in seminars, symposiums, training, workshops and meetings organized by the government health department.

An expert from PUM Netherlands studied at Dinajpur Hospital for a week and formulated a guideline. Aloha authorities consider the guideline seriously, the implementation process of which is ongoing.

Providing medical services at low cost

From the vision, mission and values of Aloha, the poor and the very poor who are backward in the society are always given the highest priority. Medicines are provided to poor and helpless patients with subsidies, and in some cases, free medicines are provided. Especially women, children, the elderly, the disabled, common gender and ethnic communities are provided with free health check-ups and necessary medicines at low cost.

Providing special medical assistance to women including uterine tumors, breast tumors

The health workers visit families at the village level and discuss health awareness raising on women's health problems, especially menstrual problems, breast tumors, uterine tumors, use of sanitary napkins and personal hygiene. Encourages patients to go to local government hospitals for a vision test, VIA test blood sugar test and to receive services from government hospitals. Patients are advised not to fall into the any type of clutches/grip/trap of brokers and hold awareness-raising discussions about wrong treatment.

Eye Department

Aloha Hospital is a very well-known institution for eye patients. Every day, a large number of eye patients come to Aloha Health Center and Hospital for eye treatment. After the initial eye examination, a list of patients who need eye surgery is prepared and the date and time of the operation are announced after the necessary other tests for the patients selected for eye surgery. Hospital doctors, nurses, and other external specialists are invited if necessary. Eye surgeries are performed with utmost care and caution. There is an operation theater equipped with modern equipment at the Aloha.

An institution known to eye patients by Aloha hospital. Medical service center receiving multifaceted medical services every day. After the initial observation, a patient safety plan is prepared for all patients who need it and for safety, other tests related to the patient and the public are given birth during the examination. The examination doctor, nurse, OT, and external response are invited if necessary. All precautions and care are taken. Aloha health service center have equipped Operation Theater. After the examination, the patient is kept under intensive observation. During the observation period, patients are given instructions at home under their own responsibility. Patients are followed up intensively for a month. Immediate action is taken if any abnormality is found. The highest quality is maintained in the administration and use of medicines and sup.

Midwifery, Gynecology & Surgery

Aloha Hospital has recruited 06 midwives for safe and low cost normal delivery. The midwifery department has been started in the hospital with midwifery diploma degree holders from various reputed institutions. Orientation was organized for the candidates as part of the recruitment process. Refresher training was organized for the midwives after 3 months of work. Under the direct supervision of the Medical Officer (Gynecologist) of the hospital, Dr. Zulekha Afroza Ritu, the midwifery health workers are on a regular basis successfully playing a significant role in delivering to pregnant women in a normal way without surgery. The midwifery department is playing an important role in increasing the reputation of the hospital.
